which is the long rod running through the center of the wheel. More often than not, the skewer and mating bolt on the other end can be easily screwed off by hand.

1. Raise and support the vehicle under frame members. Remove the affected wheel. If using a lug wrench, you'll need to loosen the lug nuts before raising the vehicle.
2. Remove the brake drum or caliper and rotor.
3. Broken studs will need to be punched back through the flange with the hammer and punch.

**How to Change Broken or Damaged Wheel Studs**

To change wheel bearings, start by lifting the wheel up on a jack, unscrewing the lug nuts, and taking the wheel off. Then, remove the brake caliper, the dust cover over the rotor, and the cotter pin and castle nut behind the dust cover. Next, pull the rotor off, remove the old hub, and take apart the hub assembly to access the wheel bearings.
