In this term, the "Third Culture" commonly refers to the combination of the expatriate culture in which the student often lives, the culture of their passport country, and the culture of their host country. Third Culture Kids / Global Nomads - Lewis & Clark Third culture kids, or TCKs, are individuals who have spent some of their developmental years outside their parents' home country (Tanu, 2012), and were thus submerged into two or more different cultures. They have adopted elements of each, to form what has
